ABOUT POST UNIVERSITY

Founded in 1890 and located in Waterbury, Connecticut, Post University is a traditional University with an excellent online accelerated degree program for working adults. The University added online programs to its traditional campus-based program offerings in 1997.

Our accelerated Degree Programs can be completed entirely online, and during evenings and weekends at regional locations in Danbury, Meriden, Norwalk and on our main campus in Waterbury, Connecticut. ADP students also can take a mix of online and face-to-face classes, depending on the degree program they choose.

ADP PERSISTENCE RATES

The percentage of students who took a class in one MOD and then took a class in the next MOD in the 2009-2010 academic year was 84% among undergraduate students and 95% among graduate students.

ADP GRADUATION RATES

43% of matriculated bachelor's degree students who entered the University in 2004 had graduated by May 2011; 11% are still taking courses towards their degrees.

Post University began offering graduate degree programs in 2006. Of the matriculated students enrolled in graduate programs in 2006, 56% have already graduated and 10% are still taking classes.

MILITARY PROGRAMS
