Additional Certificate Requirements:

- 1. A minimum of 21 accounting credits must be taken at Post University.*
- 2. A minimum of 9 credits in non-accounting business courses must be taken at Post University.*
- 3. It is strongly recommended that all courses or accounting courses taken more than five years ago be either audited or retaken.*

TOTAL AVAILABLE TRANSFER CREDITS: 18

Credits accepted in transfer have no effect on your grade point average while you are in attendance at Post University. These credits apply only toward your certificate. You are required to maintain a 2.0 cgpa while in attendance at Post University.

You are cautioned not to take any of the transferred courses at Post as you will forfeit the grades and credits earned.
