Prior to joining Post University, he taught at the University of New Haven and Nova Southeastern University, Sacred Heart University, and Naugatuck Valley Community College. Dr. Nardozzi also is a Certified Police Instructor in the State of Connecticut.

Dr. Nardozzi retired as the Deputy Chief of Police of the Waterbury, Connecticut Police Department. He has investigated more than 75 murders and has testified in both state and federal court, as well as at state labor board hearings.
