Anthony Fallacaro is in his fourth year as Director of Athletics at Post University. During his tenure, he has led the growth of the athletic department by adding three sports teams and additional staff members. Under his direction, the Golf team has won 4 consecutive CACC conference championships, and the Men's Soccer team won the CACC Championship in 2008. Mr. Fallacaro also will be in charge of the University's first-ever

football program when the Post University Collegiate Sprint Football team takes to the field in 2010 against such well-known teams as Army, Navy, Princeton and Cornell.

Prior to joining Post University, Mr. Fallacaro served one year as the Director of Athletics at Kingsborough Community College, and two years at St John's University as the assistant director of athletic programs.

At St. John's, Mr. Fallacaro was responsible for the cultivation and growth of the entire athletic alumni population and helped maintain and interact with alumni throughout the world. He was a key member of the athletic development team that worked toward a \$25 million goal for the University's Capital Campaign and coordinated the first-ever comprehensive annual fun coaches mailing, including all 17 sports and support groups.

Mr. Fallacaro served as an assistant baseball coach at St. Johns from 1997-99, under Head Coach Ed Blankmeyer, helping to guide the Red Storm to the 1997 Big East Tournament Championship and to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. He was the staff's liaison to Major League Baseball scouts, and coached 10 players who went onto pursue professional careers.
